The prayer in the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.259 dated 15.11.2022 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 186, 353, 332, 148 and 149 at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

On 12.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel submits that in the alleged incident, 8 injuries were inflicted upon the complainant.

Even though as per reply, there is nothing on record to suggest any specific attribution of injury upon the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused Suraj Kumar and since nothing is to be recovered from him, his custodial interrogation is not required and he is ready to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 19.07.2023.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar submits that the petitioner has not joined investigation.

In view of the non-cooperation of the petitioner and the apparent violation of the order dated 12.05.2023, the present petition stands dismissed.
