AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 for conducting re-investigation by an independent agency in FIR No. 103, dated 10th September, 2018, under Sections 21, 22, 25, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 and 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Kulgharhi, District Ferozepur.

2. Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 26th April, 2019. As per the reply, challan was presented on 25th January, 2019 and charges were framed on 27th February, 2019.

3. *In spite* of two pass overs, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the position on the last two dates.

4. The charges having been framed, there is no ground is made out for interference by this Court at this stage for re-investigation of the matter.

5. The petition is dismissed.

6. Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, if any.

7. Since the main case has been dismissed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
