On 16.03.2023, the following order was passed by this

Court:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.271 dated 07.11.2022 for the offences under Sections 326, 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel while drawing the attention of this Court to the allegations levelled in the FIR in question inter alia contends that it is evident that other than their presence having been shown at the time of alleged occurrence, no injury much less under Section 326 IPC has been attributed to them.

Notice of motion for 01.05.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of their arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC”

On the next date of hearing i.e. 01.05.2023, it was informed by learned State Counsel that petitioners have already joined the investigation. However, grant of bail was opposed by counsel for the complainant.

Today there is no representation on behalf of the complainant.

In view of the above, order dated 16.03.2023 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners in the FIR in question, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer and make compliance of the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
