The Prayer in this petition under Section 439 Cr.PC is for the grant of regular bail in case FIR No.186 dated 30.12.2022 under Sections 379-A, 34 IPC and Section 411 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Central, Sector 17, Chandigarh.

2. The brief facts of the case are that the instant FIR came to be registered on the statement of Renu who stated that two unknown boys snatched her mobile phone and fled away from the spot.

3. The Counsel for the petitioner contends that he has been falsely implicated in the present case. A compromise (Annexure P-2) has been entered into between the parties. Since the petitioner was in custody for more than 02 months, his further incarceration was not required.

4. The Counsel for the State while opposing the bail application contends that the nature of the allegations levelled against the petitioner did

not entitle him to the grant of bail. He however does not deny the fact that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

5. The Counsel for the complainant admits the factum of a compromise having been entered into between the parties and does not oppose the bail application.

6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

7. Admittedly the petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last more than 02 months. A compromise Annexure P-3 has been entered into between the parties. Therefore, his further incarceration is not required.

8. Thus without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-**Ashok Verma** son of Sh. Vinod is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

9. The petition stands disposed of.
