The prayer in the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.100 dated 15.07.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC and Sections 325, 326, 201, 148 and 149 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Sadar Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

On 11.05.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as the petitioner has been granted bail under Section 167(2) Cr.P.C.

The Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar is directed to hold a fact finding inquiry as to why there was delay in the filing of the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. and file a report before the adjourned date.

Adjourned to 22.05.2023”.

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Thereafter, a status report dated 20.05.2023 was filed in the Court. A perusal of the same would reveal that a departmental action has been initiated against ASI Gulzar Singh because of whom a report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. was presented on the 91st day.

In view of the affidavit/status report filed on behalf of the respondent-State, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
