HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) by which the petitioner has been reverted from the post of Multi Purpose Health Supervisor (Female) to Multi Purpose Health Worker (Female).

2. As per the averments made in the writ petition, the order dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) has been challenged on the ground that despite the fact that a due reply was given to the show cause notice raising objection to the proposal of reversion but while passing the impugned order, no such grounds taken were considered.

3. As per the petitioner, a cryptic and non-speaking order has been passed, which cannot be sustained as all the executive orders are required to be passed with due reasons to support the ultimate opinion reached by the authorities concerned.

4. Faced with this situation, learned State counsel, on the instructions from Mr. Gaurav Sharma, Deputy Superintendent O/o Director Health Service, Haryana, submits that order dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) may kindly be treated as having withdrawn with liberty to the authority to pass a fresh order in accordance with law.

5. Keeping in view the fact that the impugned order dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-8) has already been withdrawn, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is accordingly disposed of as such. However, the respondents will be at liberty to pass appropriate order afresh in accordance with law.
