1. Mr. Sharma submits that the present revision petition has been rendered infructuous.
2. It is submitted that challenge raised in the present petition is to the order dated 04.01.2020 (Annexure P-4), whereby the application for restoration of the application under Order 9 Rule 9 CPC, was allowed. Thereafter, the suit that was dismissed in default vide order dated 02.02.2015, was restored and subsequently the main suit stands dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 23.03.2023. A copy of the judgment dated 23.03.2023 has been produced in Court, which is taken on record.
3. It is further submitted that the instant petition arises from the suit, which has since culminated on passing of the judgment noticed above and thus, it is prayed that the present petition be disposed of accordingly.
4. None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner to

controvert the aforesaid submission. In light of the main suit having been decided finally and the impugned order stands merged in the judgment dated 23.03.2023, nothing survives for adjudication in the present petition, as such.

5. Accordingly, no useful purpose would be served to keep the present petition pending.

6. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
