This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate, writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the order dated 27.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1.

In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the remand order dated 27.09.2018 (P-5), in which, it was mentioned that the parties were directed to approach the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Commissioner (Sales), Ambala on 15.10.2018 and in the present writ petition nothing has been stated as to what proceedings had taken place after the said remand order dated 27.09.2018.

The petitioner has sought to draw parity with an order passed

in a case where the nature of the land was 'Sailaab' , whereas, in the present case, the land in possession of the petitioner is 'Barani'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars and also after annexing the zimni orders to show that as to whether after the remand order dated 27.09.2018, any decision has been taken or not.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
