The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for restraining respondent Nos.1 to 3 from entertaining and conducting multiple inquiries on false and concocted motivated complaints from respondent Nos.4 and 5 family members on the same set of allegations roping the entire family members of the petitioners.
