The report dated 17.07.2023 of learned Trial Court has been received, which reads as under:-

“With reference to order dated 10.04.2023 passed by Hon'ble Mr Justice Deepak Gupta, Judge, High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh in CRM-M-22032-2018 in case titled as "Som Nath & ors Vs. State of Punjab & Anr" vide which trial court was directed to record the statements of the parties vide order dated 10.04.2023, with regard to genuineness of compromise and number of accused involved, if all the parties are party to compromise, no accused is absconding or P.O. Trial Court was also directed to record the statement of IO to the effect that no other accused or aggrieved person is involved, I have the honour to submit that the said order of Hon'ble High Court is received by the Court of undersigned on 17.04.2023. It is further submitted that in the present case, Sessions Trial was received by the Court of undersigned on 16.09.2022 and all the accused persons including the petitioners in CRM-M- 22032-2018 namely Som Nath, Bobby, Babli and Ram Lal @ Lally have already been acquitted vide judgment dated 05.12.2022 as the main witnesses of prosecution were turned hostile.”
