The petitioner has approached this Court through the instant Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order/judgement dated 19.03.2021 passed by the court of learned Additional District Judge, Sangrur, whereby the appeal preferred by the plaintiffs/respondents has been allowed, by setting aside the order dated 24.11.2020 passed by the court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Sangrur, vide which the application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 of CPC filed by the respondents-plaintiffs was dismissed.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, Sh. Amit Kumar Walia, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent nos.1 and 2 and filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner/defendant submits that the main suit i.e. Civil Suit No.793 of 2020 titled as '*Manjit Singh and another versus Naranjan Singh*' has itself been withdrawn by the plaintiffs/respondents on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties and this fact has also been affirmed by learned counsel appearing for the respondents, therefore, he wishes to withdraw the present petition, as having been rendered infructuous.
