This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

Mr. Anup Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – The Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar (Punjab) to consider and decide the representation dated 11.03.2023 (Annexure P-5 marked to SSP, Batala) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for their life and liberty.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2– The Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Amritsar (Punjab), that if any such representation, as

indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
