Prayer in the present petition is for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2-Punjab State Disputes Redressal Commission to decide the bail applications of the petitioner pending in M.A. No.1035 of 2020 dated 08.06.2020 (Annexure P-5) as well as in M.A. No.350 of 2022 (Annexure P-8).

Learned State Counsel on instructions from Shri Vinay Sharma, Sr. Assistant has informed that the petitioner has already been released on bail. He thus contends that present petition has become infructuous insofar as the relief for claimed by the petitioner is concerned.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today to dispute or controvert the same.
