The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.20 dated 18.02.2023 under Section 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation), Act, 2014 registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.03.2023 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Nirmal Singh, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Sub Division Central, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab and on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh

submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 17.03.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 17.03.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
