DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

On 24.03.2023, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Status report not filed by the State counsel. Learned State counsel submits that due to short time, reply could not be prepared.

Counsel for the petitioner requests that in the meantime, petitioner be protected from arrest. Learned counsel also submits that in order to show her bonafide, she is ready to deposit an amount of ₹2,64,000/-, which is under dispute before the Trial Court within a period of one month.

Adjourned to 10.05.2023 for filing status report.

Petitioner is directed to deposit the amount of ₹2,64,000/- in the shape of FDR and submit the same before learned Area Magistrate within a period of one month.

In the meantime, petitioner is also directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. She will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, she shall be released on interim bail on her furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the

1st Class, Ambala revealing that in compliance of the order dated 24.03.2023, the petitioner has deposited the amount of ₹2,64,000/- in the form of FDR.

Learned State counsel concedes that petitioner has joined the investigation as per order dated 24.03.2023.

For the reasons as discussed in the order dated 24.03.2023 and considering the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and complied the said order, the interim bail earlier granted to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
