The present petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the grant of all the requisite benefits as are admissible to the dependents/children/grand children of the freedom fighters.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even though the respondents have taken a stand in their written statement that the petitioner had not participated in the freedom struggle, however, in the undertaking sent to him by the respondents, they have accepted that the petitioner is grandson of late Sardar Nidhan Singh, who was a freedom fighter. He contends that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case his representation Annexure P-2 dated 19.06.2014 is directed to be decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State Counsel, while disputing the entitlement of the petitioner has no objection to the abovesaid prays being accepted.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties, without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner to examine the representation dated 19.06.2014 (Annexure P-2) and to pass a speaking and reasoned order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this Court, after granting opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.
