The present petition has been filed for seeking quashing/setting aside of the order dated 20.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) and Notice dated 11.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) issued by the respondents- Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana.

Ms. Seema Arora, Advocate enters appearance on behalf of the respondent-Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana and submits that the impugned order is an appealable order and that the petitioner has an efficacious remedy of appeal before the Bar Council of India.
