Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the order dated 18.02.2021 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sohna, the vehicle is not being released on superdari.

In the affidavit of SHO, P.S. Bhondsi, Gurugram, filed in the Court today, a stand is taken that one year prior to passing of the aforesaid order, the vehicle was handed over to Noida Police, as some other FIR was registered with regard to same Engine and Chasis numbers.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this petition may be disposed of and the petitioner may be relegated to his remedy to approach the competent Court at Noida for redressal of his grievance
