The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the complaint bearing No.3 dated 03.09.2008 (Annexure P-2) under Sections 326, 324, 323, 382, 384, 427, 34 IPC alongwith summoning order dated 23.01.2012 (Annexure P-3) under Sections 326, 323 IPC and P.O. order dated 29.10.2014 (Annexure P-7) passed by the ACJM, Gurdaspur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

On a query as to when the petitioner shall return to the country to join proceedings, the learned counsel for the petitioner suggests that the same would be possible only after three months. Therefore, at this stage quite clearly, the present petition is not maintainable. This petition has been filed only to buy time as the petitioner does not have the intention to return and face proceedings.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
