This petition has been filed against the order dated 03.02.2023 passed by the Family Court granting interim maintenance of ₹15,000 against notional rent to the respondent-wife.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it was only on account of inadvertent mistake that the petitioner-husband wrongly ticked in his status as 'high' in column no.82 in the 'Affidavit of Assets, Income and Expenditure'. Infact, the petitioner's income is ₹14,500 per month only, and the Family Court has granted interim maintenance of ₹15,000 towards notional rent primarily by alluding to his 'clan' and 'high' status, though there is no mention of his 'clan' anywhere. He, therefore, seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to move appropriate application before the Family Court seeking correction of the 'Affidavit of Assets, Income and Expenditure' dated 12.05.2022 filed before the Family Court, and thereupon seek

modification of the order dated 03.02.2023 also.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty prayed for.
4. In case any such application is filed by the petitioner before the Family Court, the same shall be considered and decided on its own merits.
