
attorney which is taken on record and also admits the factum of compromise.

The allegation qua the petitioner is that he has forged the documents, which were used for the purpose of fabricating the sale agreement and now the parties have entered into compromise.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed by learned State counsel is taken on record. According to custody certificate the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of 6 months and 21 days and is not involved in another case of any nature.

Considering the afore-said facts and circumstances and the period so far undergone by the petitioner i.e. 6 months and 21 days particularly in view of the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise and decided to live peacefully, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands allowed in view of the afore-said terms.

However, it is made clear that anything stated hereinabove, shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
