The petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 immediately stop the enquiry proceedings with regard to complaint No.209-PESHI dated 26.02.2020 filed by respondent No.5 Jagdip Kaur for registration of a case against the petitioner and his family.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that time and again frivolous complaints are being filed against the petitioner and enquiries are being conducted by the authorities. He submits that on enquiry of the allegations made in the complaint at the behest of respondent No.5 no truth was found. He submits that despite that frivolous complaints are being filed and enquiries are being conducted.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, has submitted that there is no enquiry pending against the petitioner as on date and he is not wanted in any case.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition as learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner is not wanted by them in any complaint.

The present petition is disposed of accordingly.
