The petitioner is praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant requisite prosecution sanction for registration of FIR on the basis of inquiry conducted by AIG, EOW Department of Vigilance, Punjab.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents No.7 to 12 has filed status report which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. While drawing the attention of this Court to the status report, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the requisite prosecution

sanction for registration of FIR, already stands granted under Section 17(a) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

In view of the reply filed on behalf of the respondents, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the instant petition may be disposed of being infructuous.
