Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners. Further prayer has been made to direct respondents No.3 to 12 to not harass and take any coercive measures against the petitioners in relation to the matter regarding the transfer deed, which is pending adjudication in the Civil Court.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the petition, bearing Civil Revision No.6393 of 2016, filed in respect of the Transfer Deed, already stands decided by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 13.03.2020, and now the matter is pending adjudication before the Supreme Court, therefore, he may be permitted to

withdraw the instant petition, at this stage.

3. Keeping in view the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
