JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 30.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) whereby petitioner has been transferred from Composite Hospital BSF, Jalandhar Cantt. to Composite Hospital BSF, Tekanpur, Madhya Pradesh, ignoring family circumstances of the petitioner.

2. The petitioner at present is working at Composite Hospital BSF, Jalandhar Cantt. and she has been transferred to Tekanpur, Madhya Pradesh vide order dated 30.03.2021 (Annexure P-1).

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that daughter of the petitioner is studying in 12th standard and she at present is studying at BSF School, Jalandhar. The transfer of petitioner in the mid of session would disturb study of her daughter and being widow lady she

is the only parent who looks after her daughter, thus, she may be permitted to continue till the completion of session of her daughter. She further submits that petitioner may be considered for posting at Jodhpur.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the respondents-UIO submits that petitioner would not be relieved till the completion of session of daughter of the petitioner and if petitioner files any representation with respect to her transfer to Jodhpur it would be sympathetically considered.

5. In the wake of statements of both side, the present petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending misc. application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
