Petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 10.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) in a Complaint Case No.206, dated 10.03.2021 (CNR No.HRS1030014202021), whereby he has been declared as a proclaimed offender.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the impugned order dated 10.03.2023 (Annexure P-2) had been passed without there being any proper compliance of the provisions of Section 82 Cr.P.C. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to appear before the Court and attend proceedings which are pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sirsa. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from

today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
