The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to enquire into the complaint of the petitioner as per law and for issuance of directions to them to confiscate the passport of respondent no.4.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she would be satisfied, if, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a decision on the representation dated 23.1.2023 (Annexure P-2) already submitted by the petitioner expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

I find the prayer to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to decide the representation dated 23.1.2023 (Annexure P-2) already submitted by the petitioner within a period of one month from today in accordance with law.
