This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.4 and 5 not to deliver the possession of land measuring 8 kanals 12 marlas out of the total land measuring 31 kanals 9 marlas regarding which the partition application is pending before respondent No.3-Tehsildar-cum-A.C. Ist Grade, Tarn Taran.

Learned State Counsel and learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.9 have jointly submitted that the present writ petition in the present form is not maintainable inasmuch as the petitioner is seeking injunction against the private parties for which writ petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
