The petitioner is seeking the concession of interim bail in FIR No.484 dated 26.11.2022 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Kalanaur District Rohtak for a period of three weeks on account of marriage of his two daughters, which are scheduled to be held on 22.03.2023.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Amit Kumar has verified that the marriage of two daughters of the petitioners is due to be solemnized at village Dhahi Gujran on 22.03.2023. Learned State counsel has, however, submitted that though initially the petitioner was involved in as many as 9 criminal cases, and though in three case he stands acquitted and still further, cancellation report has been filed in two cases, however, he is facing trial in two cases registered under the NDPS Act and in two cases for offences under Indian Penal Code. Hence, if the petitioner is extended the concession of interim bail, it may not be for 3 weeks as prayed for, and only subject to heavy surety.

In view of the fact that the marriage of two daughters of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 22.03.2023, this Court deems it appropriate to enlarge him on interim bail w.e.f. 21.03.2023 to 23.03.2023 subject to furnishing of heavy surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall surrender back before the Jail Superintendent concerned on 23.03.2023 at 5.00 pm. It is further clarified that the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of District Patiala during his interim bail.
