On 28.04.2023, following order was passed:-

“State counsel submits that the petitioner is availing interim bail since 7.12.2022. The State counsel further apprised the Court that now the trial has reached at its final stage and is fixed for 9.5.2023 for recording statements of accused persons under Section 313 Cr.P..C.

The counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner made prayer that the order of interim bail be extended for a period of next 3 months on account of the medical condition of the petitioner.

As per the copy of OPD card, which is produced today by the counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner visited OPD of PGI Chandigarh on 26.4..2023 and now asked to appear again for review after 3 months.

From the perusal of the aforesaid OPD card, it appears that petitioner is not suffering from any serious ailment and even otherwise he is being provided regular treatment from PGI and is now called for follow up treatment after 3 months. So no ground is made out to extend the interim bail which was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 7.12.2022. The petitioner is hereby directed to surrender before the Court concerned/jail authorities within next 7 days, failing which, the law will

take its own course.
Now be listed on 19.7.2023.”

Custody certificate of petitioner-Kanhaiya Jha @ Ghanaiya Jha dated 14.08.2023 has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. A perusal of the custody certificate would show that the petitioner has been taken back in custody on 17.07.2023.

Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.
Dismissed for non-prosecution.
