1. The petitioner herein seeks compassionate appointment on account of his father having died in harness on 17.06.2002.
2. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that for redressal of his grievance, number of requests have been made to the respondents department, but to no avail. The petitioner has even served a legal notice dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-9), but it has also not been replied as yet. Counsel would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case his said legal notice is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion.
4. At this stage, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.
5. Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.

6. Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide legal notice dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
