Petitioner has filed this writ petition under Article 226/227 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus seeking quashing of impugned order dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2, i.e. the provisional result.

It is the case of the petitioner that he applied for the post of Head Draftsman and Draftsman in Ex-serviceman Category being fully eligible for the same and after completion of all formalities, he was called for written test. Upon clearing the written test, he was called for scrutinizing the relevant documents required for the post of Head Draftsman and Draftsman. After scrutinizing the requisite documents, applicant (petitioner) was shown at Sr. No.116 on the provisional shortlisted candidates on 14.02.2023, however, respondent No.2 rejected the claim of the petitioner on the ground that he is not having necessary experience as per the advertisement.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Uma Shankar Gupta, Director, Local Government, Punjab, Chandigarh on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record. A copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that as per reply dated 05.10.2023, grievance of the petitioner stands redressed as the candidature of the petitioner has already been taken into consideration by acknowledging his certificates and the he shall be considered for appointment for the post he has applied.

Since the prayer of the petitioner has been considered by the respondent-department and this fact has been fairly admitted in the reply, therefore, nothing survives for adjudication in the present petition.

Disposed of.

The respondents are directed to do the needful within a period of three weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
