Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of impugned order dated 04.02.2020 (P-4) passed by Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana vide which the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender in FIR No. 45 dated 04.02.2018, registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana.
