At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No.1 had filed CWP-2787-2019 which was disposed of vide order dated 25.03.2019 by granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent authority by filing a representation and in case the same was filed, the said representation was directed to be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within 8 weeks.

2. Learned counsel states that pursuant to the institution of the instant writ petition, the respondent-department on the previous date handed over copy of order No.6155 dated 24.09.2020 rejecting representation dated 05.05.2019 filed by the petitioner pursuant to the orders of the

Hon'ble High Court dated 25.03.2019 in CWP-2787-2019 and that in the circumstances, he does not press this petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 24.09.2020.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed with the liberty as prayed for.
