Instant writ petition has been filed inter alia seeking issuance of a direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue appointment letter to the petitioner for the post of Steno Typist (English) in the EBPG category.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was an applicant for the said post pursuant to Advertisement No.12/2015 and he was successful in the written examination. Counsel submits that after the scrutiny of the documents, petitioner's name was placed in the waiting list and recommended for appointment, but due to the pendency of litigation before the High Court as well as the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the respondents are not issuing appointment letter. Counsel has made a reference to orders appended as Annexure P-7 to submit that similarly placed candidates have been issued appointment letters with the stipulation that the

appointment would be subject to the decision of the writ petition and the SLP pending before the Hon’ble Supreme Court. Counsel has also made a reference to orders, Annexures P-12 to P-14, passed by this Court. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to look into the representation, Annexure P-16, submitted by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G.Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the claim as raised in the writ petition or in the representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to examine the representation, Annexure P-16, in the light of orders, Annexures P-7 and P-12 to P-14, within a period of four months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.
