VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to provide adequate security to them as they apprehend a threat to their lives from respondents No.4 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in a live-in-relationship. He further contends that though petitioner No.2 is not of marriageable age, he is a major. The private respondents are not accepting the said relationship and are extending threats to them. The copies of 'Aadhar' cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of petitioners No.1 and 2 have been placed on record.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, AAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Without commenting upon the validity of the said relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 14.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in accordance with law.
