The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent nos.2 and 3 to consider and take appropriate action against the private respondents on the representation dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-5).

Status report by way of affidavit dated 02.05.2022 of Mr. Hans Raj, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Sangrur, District Sangrur has been placed on record on behalf of the respondent/State of Punjab and para no.4 of the said status report reads as under:-

“ 4. That in view of the detailed facts submitted above, inquiry into the representation dated 02.02.2022 bearing No.861/P (Annexure P-5) as well as another application bearing No. 1992/P dated 14.03.2022 was conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Head Quarters, Sangrur and perusal

of Inquiry report No.56/57/P/R/SP (H) dated 24.03.2022 reveals that during inquiry the matter was found to be sale/purchase of cloth and give and take money and being the matter found to be of civil nature, the Inquiry Officer has recommended that no action is required to be taken by the Police on the representation and recommended the said representation to consign to the record. However, the Inquiry Officer has advised the petitioner to pursue his case before the Ld. Court. After agreeing with the said inquiry report, the said report was approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur on 31.03.2022. ”

Since, the matter has already been inquired into by the police and the same has been found to be of civil nature, therefore, in this view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
