The petitioner through instant petition, on the basis of compromise is seeking quashing of FIR No.13 dated 18.01.2020 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa, under Sections 452 and 354 of IPC, 1860.

On 04.08.2022, the parties were directed to appear before Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 30.08.2022 for recording their statements.

On 30.11.2022, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and today there is no change in the situation.

As per report dated 03.09.2022 received from Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sardulgarh, the parties have not appeared before Trial Court for recording their statements.

Learned State counsel submits that complainant has become hostile which seems to be reason of non-appearance of parties before the Trial Court as well as this Court.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

The petitioner is at liberty to move an application, if something survives.
