The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.148 dated 20.12.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Women West Gurugram,, District Gurugram (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
