Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the present Regular Second Appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the appellant to challenge the orders dated 01.04.2015 and 08.04.2015 passed against him in accordance with law before the appropriate forum as permissible under law.

Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that as the electricity connections are still running, the appellant be allowed the benefit of the said electricity connection till he avails appropriate remedy.

Once, the proceeding in respect of the impugned order is yet to be initiated by the appellant, no order can be passed by this Court as being prayed. While initiating the proceedings against the impugned order as

permissible under law, the appellant is entitled to file an application seeking interim order and this Court has no apprehension that in case any such application is filed, the same will be decided in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible so that no prejudice is caused to the appellant by the authorities concerned.

Keeping in view the above, as prayed for, the present Regular Second Appeal and civil miscellaneous application i.e. CM-2820-C of 2023 are disposed of having been not pressed with liberty as prayed for.
