This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-8) whereby respondent No.1 has set aside the order dated 29.09.2017 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the tenure of respondent No.5 has elapsed and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. It is prayed that in pursuance of order dated 25.03.2019, the petitioner had deposited Rs.25,000/- with the Registrar of this Court and the said amount be ordered to be returned to

the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

The amount of Rs.25,000/- deposited by the petitioner in pursuance of order dated 25.03.2019 is directed to be returned to the petitioner.
