SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The learned State counsel, submits, at the bar, that in view of a decision rendered by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court, appended to the petition as Annexure P-6, he does not oppose the prayer made today before this Court by the learned counsel for the petitioner, that the instant writ petition, be allowed. Hence, this Court may accordingly grant relief to the petitioner, to ensure the maintaining of the revision petition, as became preferred before the Revisional Authority concerned.

2. In view of the above statement, as made at the bar, by the learned State counsel, the instant writ petition is allowed. The order made by the Revisional Authority, declining to make a decision, in accordance with law, upon the apposite revision petition, on ground of the same being not maintainable before it, is quashed and set aside.

3. In sequel, the revision petition is ordered to be restored to its original number by the learned Revisional Authority, and, the latter is directed to within four months from today, make a lawful decision thereons, but only after hearing all concerned.
