AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition is filed seeking directions to the Additional District Judge, Chandigarh for expeditious disposal of objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short 'the Act')
2. The grievance is that objection were filed in the year 2015 and *inspite* of decision of **Supreme Court** in **M/s Chopra Fabricators and Manufacturers Pvt. Ltd. v. Bharat Pumps and Compressors Ltd. and another** decided on 10th December, 2021, the matter is still pending.
3. From the perusal of the record, it is forthcoming that no such request was made before the court concerned. Pleadings are complete and written submission has been filed.
4. No case is made out for interference at this stage. The petition is dismissed.
5. However, in case petitioner approaches the court concerned for expeditious disposal, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
