The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction of official respondents No.1 to 5 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry in complaint dated 11.02.2020 and 14.03.2020 (Annexures P-1 and P-3 respectively) and further directing the official respondents to take legal action against the accused.

As per the order dated 19.03.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been receiving threat calls from mobile No. 6289606133 on his mobile No.9257400100.

As per the reply dated 14.11.2022, learned State counsel submits that as per initial threat perception, security was provided to the petitioner but later on, after due assessment the same was withdrawn by the authorities. He further submits that since nothing has come on record regarding any fresh threat or obstructing the way of the petitioner, but still in such circumstances they are duty bound to protect the life and liberty of the State's citizens.

Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client submits that even today fresh threats are being received by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the submissions made by the petitioner, State is directed to look into the grievances of the petitioner, in accordance to law if he moves an application qua receiving threats against his life and liberty.

Since the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed and nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of.
