This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.98 dated 01.10.2008 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323/324/34 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sudhar, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise and affidavit dated 08.04.2009 (Annexure P-2 and P-3).

Vide order dated 25.03.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 23.04.2019 to record their statements with reference to the compromise, if any, entered between them. As per report received from the court of Ld. JMIC, Jagraon, only petitioner had appeared for getting his statement recorded and as such, no effective compromise has been effected between the parties. Counsel for the petitioner sought various adjournments for serving respondent Nos.2 and 3, however, they have not been served as correct/fresh addresses were not furnished by the counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that they are living abroad.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of

action at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
