[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for setting aside order dated 20.12.2018 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge, Jalandhar, staying the operation of notice dated 08.05.2018 issued by the petitioners to the respondents.

[2] Learned counsel for the parties have placed on record copy of order dated 26.03.2021 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge, Jalandhar in Appeal under Section 269(2) of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 against the issuance of notice by the petitioners dated 08.05.2018 vide Memo No.MTP-3875 regarding demolition of the property of the respondents-appellants, allowing the appeal filed by the respondents/appellants-M/s Joshi Hospital and Dr. Neelam Joshi.

[3] Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the instant petition, challenging the order dated 20.12.2018 passed by the learned Addl. District Judge, Jalandhar, staying the operation of notice dated 08.05.2018 has become infructuous.
