1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking quashing of impugned order dated 29.10.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the respondent-authorities and for declaring the petitioner as eligible for the post of 'Full Time Pointsman' on compassionate grounds.

2. Mr. S.K. Sharma, Advocate who is present in Court on advance notice for the respondents, at the outset, points out that deceased was an employee of Northern Railways, thus, petitioner has remedy to approach Central Administrative Tribunal and this Court should not entertain the present petition at the first instance.

3. On being confronted with the aforesaid fact, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy as permissible by law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
