1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.107 dated 08.03.2019 registered under Section 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines Kaithal, District Kaithal.
2. Vide order dated 09.04.2021, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and vide order dated 05.01.2023, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner, passed by Coordinate Benches.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 05.01.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kulwinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 05.01.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
