1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to quash the impugned order dated 13.02.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed in criminal appeal No. CRA-349-2023 titled as "Rajesh Kumar Goyal Vs. M.s V.K Sales Private Limited and Others" pending before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, whereby the bail order has been ordered to be cancelled and the bail/surety bonds were ordered to be cancelled and forfeited to the State for non-payment of 20% of the amount of compensation.

2. Mr. Raghujeet Singh Madan, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 by filing his Vakalatnama, which is taken on record and Mr. Krishan Kanha, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 by filing his Vakalatnama, which is also taken on record.

3. Today during the Court proceedings, learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a drafts Nos.059105 and 059106 for an amount of

Rs.2,60,792/- each i.e20% of the amount of compensation (26,07,920/-) imposed by the Trial Court to the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1/complainant and sufficient compliance has been made by the petitioner.

4. Even learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 has no objection, in case the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail and a condition is imposed on him that he shall continue to appear before the Ist Appellate Court during the pendency of the appeal.

5. In view of the above, the impugned order dated 13.02.2023 is ordered to be set aside and the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned Ist Appellate Court within a period of one week from today and on his appearance before the Ist Appellate Court, he shall be admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned Court.

6. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the First Appellate Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absented himself during the proceedings, except with prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition disposed off.
