AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to get the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.37 dated 03.02.2023, Annexure P-2, under Sections 341 and 148 of the IPC at Police Station B Division from some higher official.

2. Learned counsel submits that the complainant-respondent No.4 is involved in two FIRs and he has already been declared a proclaimed offender. The petitioner is an innocent person and has not committed any crime. Thus, he prays that the enquiry of the FIR be got done in a fair, free and impartial manner and without any pressure.

3. Learned State counsel, submits on instructions from ASI Harjit Singh that investigation is going on, after which the final report under Section 173 CrPC shall be submitted. There are no specific allegations made in the petition against the investigating agency, which would indicate that proper investigation is not being conducted.

4. Heard.
5. It is apparent from the petition that the averments made therein are vague and nothing has been mentioned that would lead this Court to a conclusion that investigation is not being conducted in a fair and proper manner. Even during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to make out any case that the investigation being conducted pursuant to the FIR lodged against the petitioner lacks credibility. That being the position, the police machinery is investigating the matter, as they are duty-bound to do. Thus, no ground is made to allow the prayer made in the petition.
6. Sequelly, the present petition sans merit and is hereby dismissed.
